- 1.01 In order to accommodate the software package and timing system used in the Pinewood Derby races conducted by Pack 800 dated 1/20/07, the following amendments to the Pinewood Derby rules already published, will be required.
- 1.02 All cars shall be pre-registered for compliance of all applicable construction rules, and for size and weight in order to compete in the official races on 1/20/07.
- 1.03 Pre-registration will be at the specific location of the Cubmaster's Residence (ask your Den Leader for the address and directions).
- 1.04 Pre-registration is available Wednesday 1/17/07 thru Friday 1/19/07 only. Cars not pre-registered within this requirement, such as cars presented for races for the first time on the day of the event, shall not be eligible for official races, but will be eligible for racing on the second track without limitations and as the second track rules dictate.
- 1.05 Pre-registration times will be from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM only.
- 1.06 At the time of pre-registration, all cars that are destined for the official race shall be sequestered by race officials until the day of the race. Until elimination from the official races, cars will not be available to the owner or anyone else for any reason other than withdrawal from the official races.
- 1.07 On the day of the race, an official of the race will apply graphite lubricant to all cars prior to racing. Please do not attempt to apply graphite lubricant within the rented room of the race as it makes a tremendous mess and we are obligated to keep the room clean. No other lubricants are allowed at any time as per rules.
- 1.08 During the races, the race announcer will call periodically for Rank advancements and Achievement Awards by Dens. Due to this important aspect of our Pack Meeting, the Race Director shall temporarily halt racing. No racing shall be conducted during this activity. Nor shall the races commence again until the Cubmaster is satisfied with the completion of delivering the Awards to the hard working Scouts who have earned them. Your cooperation is requested in helping to maintain focus from the Scouts, siblings as well as the adults during these Awards. The faster the audience honors the honorees, the faster the races resume.
