Holiday Family Camp, as are all Council programs, is open to all currently registered members of the Boy Scouts of America. This program is a family weekend and rules for acceptance and participation in this program are the same for everyone without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, or handicap. Something special for all ages has been planned. Activities can be found at most of Lost Valley's program areas: swimming, horseback riding, rifle, shotgun, BB and archery shooting, hiking, nature walks, mountain biking, campfires, movies, sports, tournaments, and more! (Some fee and age restrictions apply).

We recommend that families tent camp. (Youth not members of your family may not share your tent). Campsite assignments are made on a first come first served basis. If you wish to camp with another family please turn in your applications at the same time. Each family must submit a separate reservation form. Cost is \$25 per person (age 7 and over), \$17 (children ages 4-6), and children ages 3 and under are free. Arrive as early as 3 p.m. Friday and departure is by noon on Monday. Bring your own tents and food, we'll supply the fun. A confirmation pamphlet with your campsite and notes about camp will be mailed approximately 1 to 2 weeks prior to the campout. **Cancellations must be made in writing at least two weeks prior to the Family Camp weekend and are subject to a 15% cancellation charge.**

ARRIVAL TIME: Camping over the holiday weekend is available from 3 p.m. on Friday to noon on Monday. Since many families are "first time" visitors to the Valley, it is recommended that you arrive in camp by 6 p.m. Friday. Allow 3 to 4 hours driving time from most points in Orange County. The registration area will be manned from 3 p.m. to 9 p.m. Friday. If you arrive after 9 p.m. please check in at Grace Trading Post, during the hours of operation.

PARKING: There will be guides to greet and direct you to your campsite and give you parking and driving instructions for the weekend. Once you reach your campsite please be prepared to walk or ride your bike the rest of the weekend.

TRAILER CAMPING: Camping in trailers or other "non-tent" vehicles is allowed but only in designated areas.

Our volunteer staff has many things in store for you. Please bring appropriate "gear" for all of our activities. We hope to bring you such favorites as shotgun, rifle and black powder. Some swimming and games to cool off in the afternoon. Horseback rides and hiking tours throughout the weekend. Handicrafts, BB and Archery, tournaments, movies, campfires and much more!

We will be opening our Trading Post for your convenience but we have a limited number of camping supplies. Goodies, snacks, sodas, water, batteries and Lost Valley souvenirs abound! (Visa, MC, Amex, Check with proper ID and cash)

A non-denominational worship will be held at 9 AM on Sunday for those who wish to attend.
