SHOOTING SPORTS CAMP WEEKEND

Welcome to our Shooting Sports Weekend at Rancho Las Flores. We will have plenty of activities to keep you busy!

You and your son may arrive Friday any time between 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. for check-in located at the barn. Our first activity will be a cracker-barrel (chips, cheese, coffee, and cocoa) and safety session beginning at 7:30 p.m. **Dinner will not be served.** Plan to arrive early so you have time to look around and set up your campsite. Campsites are set up on a first-come basis.

Here is a list of items to bring with you to make your stay more comfortable:

Also, check the weather and plan accordingly.

Meals that are included in the fee are breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday. Activity sessions will begin Saturday with opening ceremonies and conclude Sunday after "Scout's Own" services. A schedule will be available at camp. There are plenty of restroom facilities for our guests, but not any showers.

If you require a tent be provided, please notify us at check-in. A \$20 deposit reserves your tent and is refundable upon satisfactory return of the tent. (Tent consists of a canvas Boy Scout wall tent that tie closed with no floor. Cots are provided.)

REFUND POLICY: Most of the fees for an event are actually spent prior to your arrival at camp. (Food is already ordered, staff secured, and program supplies are all purchased based upon your commitment.) When you cancel, even for great reasons, the costs we have already spent for your attendance and the cost to write a check for a refund has to be paid for by someone. For these reasons, we have adopted the following refund policy: **All cancellations must be made in writing at least two weeks prior to the event. All refunds are subject to a cancellation fee of 15%.**

Be sure to have your current vehicle insurance, registration, and current driver's license to enter the military base.

The staff is looking forward to your participation and to an exciting adventure at Rancho Las Flores. We know that you will enjoy yourselves.
